Extension of Requests for nursery / day-care center?, etc. to Self-restraint

Thank you for your continued cooperation in the operation of day care and educational facilities.

In this city, we have been cooperating with guardian on the use of nursery / day-care center?, etc. under the declarations of emergencies in accordance with the Yokohama City Child and Youth Bureau Childcare and Educational Administration Section Director's Notice "Request for further self-restraint of nursery / day-care center?, etc. to Prevent the Expansion of New Coronavirus Infectious Diseases."

According to the "Declaration of Emergency Situation" issued by the Government on April 7, 2020 and the notice from Kanagawa Prefecture, the period covered by the Declaration of Emergency Situation is up to May 6, but as of April 28, no decision has been made on the direction of extension or cancellation of the Declaration of Emergency Situation.

In order to ensure stable nursery / day-care center? operation immediately after the opening of a large-scale holiday, the city will inform you of the direction of response from Thursday, May 7 onward.

We would like to ask guardian and children to understand and cooperate with the goal of keeping children in nursery / day-care center? and other areas while preventing the spread of new corona virus, despite continuing self-restraint and inconvenience.

1 When the period of the declaration of an emergency situation has been extended
Continue handling based on the current response (*).

2 When the declaration of emergency is terminated

Regardless of the decision of the Government to terminate the declaration of emergency situations, the current response (*) is from Thursday, May 7, 2020 to Thursday, May 10, 2020.

It will be extended to (day). The Government of Japan will inform the Government of the response to nursery / day-care center?, etc. on and after Monday, May 11, on the week of May 7, based on the Government's judgment, etc.

[Guardian occupational requirements, etc.]

(Occupation falling under the category of "Facilities Necessary for Maintaining Social Life" in the Kanagawa Prefectural Implementation Policy Pertaining to Emergency Measures under the Special Measures Act)

When both parents of the school child meet the following occupational requirements, making it difficult for children to take care of children at home.

- ①Healthcare professionals (doctors, nurses, pharmacists, public health nurse, etc.)
- ②Workers who support public utilities (public transportation, water, gases, electricity, etc.)
- ③Employees of welfare facilities, etc. (elderly facilities, facilities for the disabled, nursery / day-care center?, etc.)
- ④Employees (wholesale markets, grocery sales halls, convenience stores, etc.) at sales facilities for daily necessities, etc.
- ⑤Other personnel engaged in facilities, etc. necessary for maintaining social life (police, fire
